- 3. If your product is exposed to out-of-range temperatures, remove adapter from the AC mains and allow temperature to return to the normal operating range.

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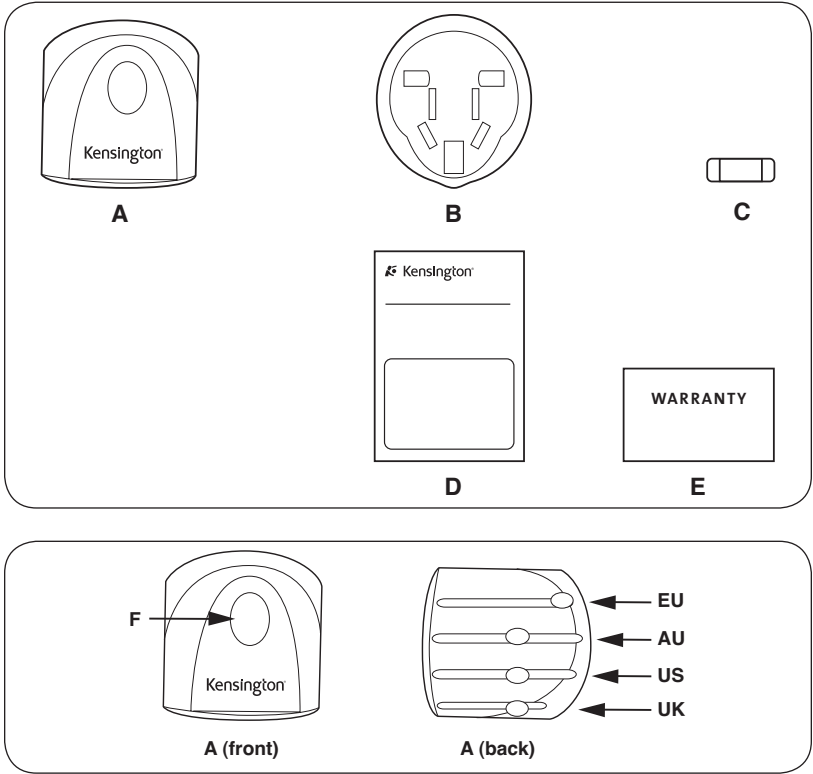

The International Travel Plug Adapter comes with a fuse installed and an extra fuse located in the adapter cap. Use only T2.5A fuses with the International Travel Plug Adapter.
