hp no.20 black inkjet print cartridges

The standard HP No.20 (6614de) and reduced volume HP No.20 (c6614ne) Black Inkjet Print Cartridges have been designed to work together with a number of new low and mid-range printers, like the HP Deskjet 610c and 640c.

Many entry level users are as aware of on-going print costs as they are of the initial purchase price of the printer. The launch of these two cartridges enables us to offer a complete, low cost solution to these customers.

capacities to match user needs

The 28ml capacity of the standard No.20 cartridge produces an average of 455 pages at 5% density and its high density pigment-based ink ensures crisp black text and graphics from the first to last page. A simple drop-in, snap-out action allows quick, easy and clean replacement.

There is also a light user option, with a 14ml capacity. This will print up to 228 pages at 5% density and will appeal to low volume or infrequent users, for whom a low cartridge price is often a key purchasing decision.

hp print quality and reliability

The only difference between these two cartridges is the volume of ink. Both have been designed to work together with the new low-to-mid range printers and to deliver sharp black text and crisp clear graphics on any paper, also on the plain paper that low volume customers use every day.

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frequently asked questions

with which printers will the no.20 black cartridge work?

The No.20 black inkjet print cartridge has been designed to work together with the HP Deskjet 610c and 640c. Together with HP papers and films, these printers – and the No.20 cartridges – are a integrated printing solution which ensures that results are always clear and always sharp.

who will be the main users of no.20 cartridges?

As the No.20 cartridges have been designed for these low-to-mid range printers, users are likely to be cost conscious. They might be first time buyers unsure of their likely print requirements, or could be light-to-medium volume users looking for a highly competitive cost per page.

does the competitive pricing mean reduced quality?

Not at all. Both cartridges use HP pigmented ink for consistently high quality results and 600dpi printing at speed. There is no difference between the standard and light user cartridges other than their capacity.

the hp no.20 cartridges feature integrated printheads – what are the benefits?

The use of an ink cartridge with its own integrated printhead means that every time the cartridge is replaced, the user is also installing a brand new, reliable, high performance printhead and can therefore be sure of maximum print quality and reliability.

In effect, this delivers a tune-up for the printer every time, with new ink, new connectors and new resistors ensuring that the printer delivers the same high quality of printing after many thousands of pages as it did when it was brand new.

what are the benefits of hp pigmented inks?

Proprietary water-resistant black HP ink has a high optical density and resists fading longer. These benefits combine to deliver optimal print quality – text and graphics – from the first page to the last, also on the plain office paper often used by low volume users.

how many pages will the no.20 cartridge print?

The precise yield of any cartridge depends on the amount of ink used on each page printed. On average, the standard 28ml cartridge will produce 455 pages at 5% density while the light user 14ml version will print approximately 228 pages at 5% density.

what are the main applications for printing with the no.20 cartridge?

As these cartridges are compatible with such a wide range of HP printers, the list of applications is virtually limitless. At the office, typical uses will be correspondence, business reports and presentations, while home users can produce high quality newsletters, school work, letters and much more.
