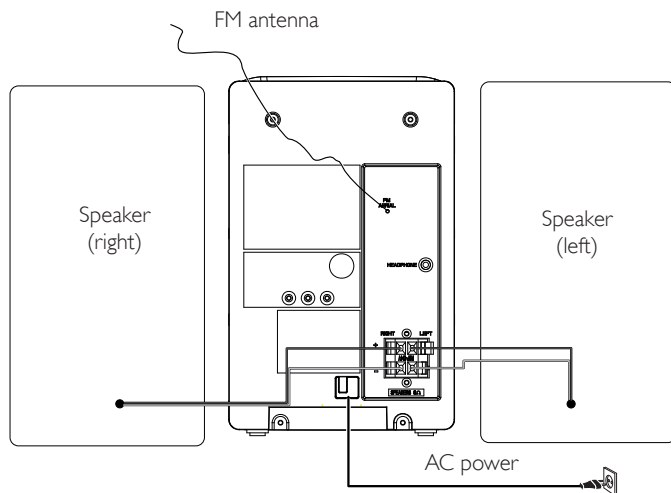
Step A *Connect*

1 Connect the speaker cables.

2 Connect the AC power cord to the wall socket.

See the *User Manual* for how to connect other equipment to this system.



Step B *Setup*

Set clock

1 Press and hold **CLOCK** (or **CLOCK/DISPLAY** on the remote control) to activate the clock setting mode.

2 Press **PROG** repeatedly to select 12 hour or 24 hour format.

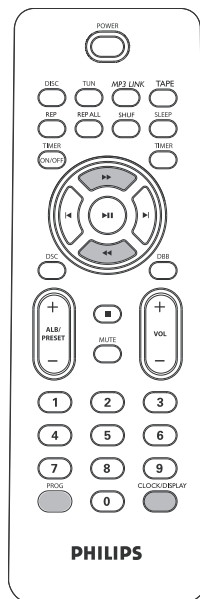
3 Press **CLOCK** (or **CLOCK/DISPLAY** on the remote control) to confirm.
→ The hour digits are displayed and begin to blink.

4 Press **◀/▶** (or **◀/▶** on the remote control) to set the hour.

5 Press **CLOCK** (or **CLOCK/DISPLAY** on the remote control) to confirm.
→ The minute digits are displayed and begin to blink.

6 Press **◀/▶** (or **◀/▶** on the remote control) to set the minute.

7 Press **CLOCK** (or **CLOCK/DISPLAY** on the remote control) to confirm.
